

To honor our alma mater's enduring contribution to our lives, we are taking this opportunity to build EnDow - the Dow Endowment Fund - which will provide us with the ability to repay our debts to our wonderful alma mater in a sustained and meaningful manner; to build a legacy we can proudly pass on to those that will come after us - one that will continue to bear fruit long after we are gone.



EnDow is premised on the idea that success and prosperity are only meaningful when they are shared in kinship and in the service of others for the betterment of our community. Our college taught us to expect more from each other than mere vocational success. So let us join hands

Dow Medical College enjoys the prestige of being the second oldest medical college in Pakistan. It was originally established as the Sindh Medical School in 1881 in Hyderabad Sindh.

EnDow was established under the auspices of the Dow Graduates Association of North America(DOGANA). It aims to provide dedicated financial support for educational programs at Dow Medical College (now Dow University of Health Sciences) and for improving the delivery of medical care at Civil Hospital Karachi.

Every notable educational institution has an endowment fund to help channel the generosity of its alumni. Endowments help institutions by enabling them to continue to meet the growing demands of changing times and also by nurturing them into becoming centers of excellence. The pace of establishing a substantial endowment fund can be slow and requires much patience and perseverance, because, unlike a fundraiser for a specific project, it does not offer instant results. But the fruits

an endowment bears in the longer term tend to be sustainable...for perpetuity.



Civil Hospital Karachi was inaugurated in 1898. It now has 1600 beds. In 2012 there were 23,462 admissions, 423,115 ER visits and 1,155,071 OPD visits.

EnDow's long-term goal is to spend income derived from the Endowment's investments every year to fund uplift efforts at Dow and CHK. Any excess earnings will be reinvested to augment the Endowment and to compensate for inflation and recessions in future years. EnDow's firm goal is to prevent the depletion of the principal amount of the Endowment Fund.

To this end, **EnDow** is managed by a board comprised of committed volunteers - all of whom are Dow-alumni with a record of service to our collective causes. **EnDow's** finances are meticulously overseen by an independent accounting firm.
